20th Anniversary Logo

To commemorate our 20th anniversary, we have created an icon that is an expression of our identity, heritage and sense of place.

At its foundation is the apple, an intentional reference to the Thornbury region and its longstanding apple growing history; a heritage that is also present on Lora Bay's own property. In this way, the symbol is not only locally rooted, but distinctly reflective of the landscape and character that surround the Club and community.

From the apple rises a central stem that branches into two forms: a leaf and a pin flag. The leaf represents the Lora Bay community; growing, connected, and enduring. The pin flag speaks to the golf course itself and to the game that remains at the heart of the Club. Together, these elements express the unique relationship between community and golf that have been at the core of Lora Bay since its founding.

These logos will be used during the 2026 season on retail merchandise and to celebrate our 20th anniversary.

The rainfall we have received this Spring has really identified one of the main issues our tree work management project was designed to correct, water coming onto our property.

This week we have seen municipal storm water management get overwhelmed and as a result created excessive flooding on to the golf course.

On the second hole specifically, pictured below, with now having machine access to this area we can create pathways for water to properly flow to stormwater management areas without exceeding the golf course's drainage capabilities.

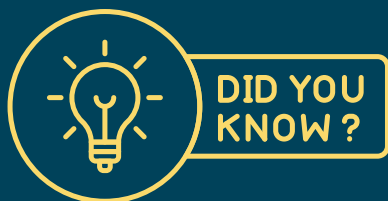

- 8 out of 10 golfers who get custom fit experience improved accuracy and consistency
- 56% of golfers who get fitted see a reduction of 5 strokes or more per round
- A study on drivers found that fitted clubs added an average of over 16 yards in distance, with 16 out of 25 players gaining over 10 yards
- Wedges should generally be replaced every 80 rounds or 1-2 years due to high wear and spin loss
- Many golfers believe they do not have the skill level for a fitting; however, fitting is beneficial for all, regardless of handicap

Guest Play

Guest play is on the rise at Lora Bay! Members are bringing more guests each year, showcasing all the great changes that have been made at the Club and we thank you.

As a reminder, we have moved the price break time on guest rates from 3:00pm in 2025 to 2:00pm in 2026, while extending the value rate season to the end of May.

In peak season, we have moved the price break time on guest rates from 4:00pm in 2025 to 3:00pm in 2026.

2026 Guest Rates & Times

Opening to May 31 & September 21 to Closing

- Before 2:00pm - \$135
- After 2:00pm - \$115
- 9-Hole - \$95

June 1 to September 20

- Before 3:00pm - \$155
- After 3:00pm - \$135
- 9-Hole - \$115

Names are required for guests at time of booking. No show or “ghost” guests will result in a fee equal to the green fee rate for that time and potential loss of guest booking privileges.

A member must be present and playing with the group for up to 3 players to receive the above rates.

A guest may play utilizing an above discounted rate or a pre-paid pass up to a maximum of 6 times in a season, regardless of the hosting member. After a guest has utilized a discounted rate 6 times, the standard public green fee rate will apply.

Up to 3 guests may be booked in member tee times, Monday to Thursday. A 1:1 member to guest ratio is permitted before 11:00am Friday to Sunday.

Members may request to host 3 guests Friday to Sunday before 11:00am by contacting Brad Brown, Head Golf Professional.
