


#### Fall Golf at Lora Bay

September marks the start of what many consider the best time of year to play golf in Central Ontario. The vibrant fall foliage creates a spectacular backdrop across the property, especially when looking out over Georgian Bay. The cooler, more comfortable temperatures make for enjoyable rounds, and the absence of summer bugs adds to the experience. Combined, these elements showcase Lora Bay at its finest and offer members and guests the perfect setting to enjoy the game.

#### **Current Course Improvements**

This month, our focus has been on enhancing high-traffic areas around greens and tees. We are installing flagstone to widen cart paths where carts and foot traffic have traditionally worn-down turf. These additions will not only reduce damage in these sensitive areas but also create a cleaner, more polished look throughout the course. The goal is to balance functionality with aesthetics, ensuring that our playing surfaces remain healthy while elevating the overall presentation of the course.



#### **Looking Ahead to Fall Maintenance**

As we move deeper into the season, our attention turns to important agronomic practices. With the help of our summer staff, we've begun core aerating the tees and applying a heavy topdressing to reduce thatch levels, improve firmness, and provide better footing. Later in the fall, typically mid to late October, depending on weather, we will aerate and topdress the greens, a process usually completed immediately after closing. Approaches will also be aerated and dressed to enhance firmness and playability moving into next season. These efforts are vital to maintaining healthy turf and ensuring the course is in strong condition heading into winter.

Thank you for your continued support and understanding as we complete these projects. We look forward to providing you with the best possible playing conditions during this beautiful time of year.

# BRIGITTE THIBAULT



Brigitte Thibault, a Rosemère, Québec native started to compete in golf at the age of 16. After two years of competitive golf, she was the only amateur player to Monday qualify for her first LPGA CPKC Canadian Women's open in 2016 at the age of 18 years old. This event led her to wanting to pursue professional golf alongside the top players in the world.

She represented her country on the international stage at the inaugural and second edition of the Augusta National Women's Championship; being the first ever Canadian women to compete on the grounds of Augusta. In 2020, Brigitte helped picked up the first ever bronze medal in golf for team Canada at the Pan American games in Peru.

National pro squad member of Team Canada and part of the team now for the 6th consecutive year, Brigitte was the #1 ranked amateur in Canada during 33 consecutive months (Dec 2018-Sept 2021).

The California Fresno state graduate and Texas Longhorn post graduate has been name 3 times All-American scholar with a cumulative GPA of over 3.7. As an amateur, Brigitte finished Top 10 in 50 tournaments of 124 events played with 6 wins under her belt. Her biggest win was the Women's western Amateur.

Turned pro 3 years ago at the CPKC Canadian Open in August 2022. Brigitte gained her tour card through finishing in the Top 5 "race for the card" on the Annika Women's all pro tour. As a Professional, Brigitte had her first professional win in 2023 at the Kathy Whitworth's Championship in Texas. She is playing full time on the Epson tour now for a 2nd consecutive year in hopes of claiming her LPGA card at the end of this year.
